BARNARD – 8 FAIRVIEW AVENUE

Applicant requested an adjournment.

APPELLE – 61 LEGRANDE AVENUE

The Board reviewed plans to install solar panels.

Chairwoman Greenwood questioned whether anyone wished to address the Board on this matter.
