WHEREAS the Village of Tarrytown has in previous years participated in a consortium of Rivertown municipalities on a shared effort to negotiate the cable franchise agreement with Altice (formerly Optimum); and

WHEREAS participation in the consortium allows the Village to share costs and increase leverage in negotiating contract items including PEG payments, PEG grants and cable service for public buildings; and

WHEREAS the agreement between the Village of Tarrytown and Verizon must now be renewed:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown does hereby authorize the Village Administrator to execute an agreement with McCarthy Fingar LLP to continue to negotiate the Verizon cable franchise agreement on behalf of the Village as part of the consortium of municipalities.

7. Bid Award for Motorcycle for Police Department

WHEREAS, the Village of Tarrytown Police Department is seeking to purchase a motorcycle for the Department, and with no available options on state or shared purchasing contract is required to issue a public bid for the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Village published a legal advertisement regarding the Motorcycle Bid on March 9, 2023; and

WHEREAS, two sealed bids were opened on Thursday, March 23, 2023 at Tarrytown Village Hall, One Depot Plaza, Tarrytown, at 11:00 a.m. E.S.T. for the contract to furnish and deliver one (1) Harley Davidson FHTP Electra Glide Police Motorcycle model year 2023, or approved equal; and

WHEREAS, the bid specification is to deliver One (1) 2023 Harley-Davidson Electra Glide FLHTP police motorcycle with listed accessories which include adaptations necessary for police operations as listed in the public bid; and

WHEREAS, the two sealed bids are listed below; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the staff that the bid be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, Empire Harley Davidson of New Rochelle per their bid of \$34,019.27.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown does hereby award the bid for one (1) Harley Davidson FHTP Electra Glide Police Motorcycle model year 2023, or approved equal to Empire Harley Davidson of New Rochelle, New York, per their bid of \$34,019.27.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with Empire Harley Davidson of New Rochelle per their bid of \$34,019.27.

8. Cancelling the April 10th Special Meeting and Scheduling a Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees for Thursday, April 6, 2023, to authorize the appointment of officers to the Tarrytown Fire Department.

BE IT RESOLVED that the date set for the Special Meeting of April 10, 2023 at 12:30 pm which was approved by resolution at the Regular Board of Trustees Meeting of March 20, 2023 is hereby rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown does hereby schedule a Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees to be held on Thursday, April 6, 2023, at 9:00 a.m., in Tarrytown Village Hall, in the second floor meeting room, in order to vote on the appointment of the new chiefs and officers of the Tarrytown Fire Department.

9. Approval of Amendment to Police Department Rules and Regulations

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in the process of accreditation through the New York State Department of Criminal Justice Services; and

WHEREAS the process requires ensuring that the published rules and regulations continue to adhere to current practices in the department and to the accreditation standards; and

WHEREAS in the review of Chapter XVII Disciplinary Procedures, minor discrepancies between current practice and the published rule were identified that need to be corrected and updated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tarrytown does hereby approve amendments to the Police Department rules and regulations as recommended by the Chief of Police.

10. Appointment of Court Clerk
